

Application for a Waiver of the “No Pass No Play” Policy

For Pre-Advanced Placement (PAP) and Advanced Placement (AP) classes

A waiver may be granted to a student who is enrolled in PAP or AP classes and has a failing grade. The student must attend tutorial sessions when learning about their failing or potentially failing status. Sponsors should monitor their students’ grades to ensure the student attends tutorials and applies for a waiver in a timely manner. However, application for a waiver is ultimately the students’ responsibility.

Waivers can only be granted if all of the following are met:

1. The student’s grade is not lower than a 60
2. The student has attended at least 5 tutorials prior to the report card that causes ineligibility
3. To receive multiple waivers for the same class, present average and the number of tutorials must be equal to or higher than the previous six weeks
